- ➤ Doctoral students may major in (1) Management Information Systems, (2) Finance, (3) Marketing, (4) Supply Chain & Operations Management, or (5) Organizational Behavior & Strategic Management.
- ➤ Our PhD students come to us from a variety of educational backgrounds. This includes individuals from backgrounds in fields as varied as Business, Engineering, Statistics, Software, the Sciences, Psychology, Economics, and Liberal Arts. Although most of our students come in with a Masters degree, we do encourage strongly qualified applicants with an undergraduate degree.
